This school participated in the Smarter Balanced Field Test in 2014, so 2013 MSP scores were used as a proxy for 2014 MSP scores.


In 2014-15, Washington State transitioned to Smarter Balanced Assessments in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.

Figure 1. Achievement Data on State Assessment in Reading/English Language Arts (ELA) from Baseline (2012) to 2015





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
