*One of the initially recommended high school Integrated Science curricula, Coordinated Science, met the composite cut score but does not have a life science component. What are the pros and cons of including this program in a final recommendation?*

*In all instances, Superintendent Dorn initially recommended only those programs that met the minimum composite cut score. In some cases, that means he listed only one or two (or, in the case of elementary, 0) programs. On what basis would you make that recommendation?*
