- Students want knowledge, not concrete decisions


Success: What we are trying to promote?


- Shift focus from 4-year college to multiple successful lifestyles for all students

 Students feel they are educating themselves on their future more than the high school






Students

Would you benefit from learning about different career and college pathways in high school?




Mt. Spokane High School Students
