
- Reported annually starting on July 31.

 - implementation of graduation pathways;
 - high school and beyond planning;
 - mastery/competency-based crediting; and,
 - implementation of 24-credit graduation requirements.

Districts that offer high school


- District-wide average of at least 1,027 in grades 1-12
- District-wide average of at least 1,000 instructional hours in grades 1-8 and 1080 in grades 9-12

Number of districts reporting that they require 24 or more credits, regardless of combination, by year



Number of districts reporting that they require all the credit components of the 24-credit framework, by year








How do districts deliver the High School and Beyond Plan?






What grade level does the district start the High School and Beyond Plan in?





Which electronic platforms are districts using for the High School and Beyond Plan?





Distribution of districts offering competency-based crediting by student enrollment for the Class of 2019






How many pathway options are offered by districts?






Number of pathways offered in high school districts by enrollment size grouping





How many high school districts offer each graduation pathway?



























Number of School Districts out of 251 High School Districts










Community Service Grad. Req. Delivery Models (Class of 2019) **Compared to 2020)**


What is the trend over time in districts allowing mastery/competency-based crediting?






How many districts offer mastery/competency-based crediting in each subject area?
