Background

- In 2001, Senior Seminar became a district-required class for seniors to complete a Reflective Letter, High School and Beyond Plan, Culminating Project, and Culminating Presentation.
- Over the years, the course changed based on feedback from students, staff, community, and state requirements.
- Currently, seniors complete College and Career Readiness Seminar as a graduation requirement.

College and Career Readiness Seminar



- In 2012-13, student feedback was collected through surveys, classroom observations, and student panels
 - Students overwhelmingly described a need for financial literacy to be taught in Senior Seminar.
- Counselors and teachers asked for a tool to support college and career readiness
 - Naviance was selected as the district's High School and Beyond Plan platform.
- In 2014-15, with a continued focus on post-secondary preparation, Senior Seminar developed into the current College and Career Readiness Seminar course.

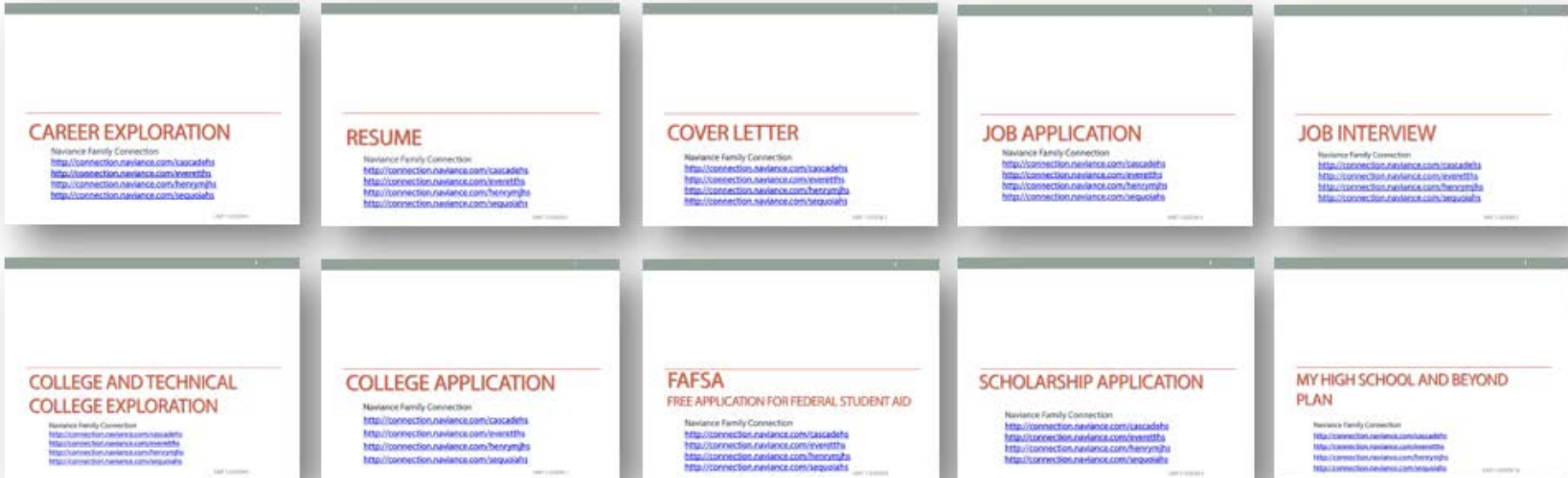
